## **Playground Update**

#### Caroline

- Extending playground into road area permanently
- Working hard with local councilors, an incredibly supportive team
- Met with local councilors
- Restricted access during school hours full road closure during those hours
- 2-part closure process
- TRO not been to public consultation yet to be progressed as urgent
- Objections not expected.
- Only material objections ie Parking would delay the process
- TRO partial closure one path of public access if this is the only option achievable then it needs to be done right.
- Formal closure of the road expected by beginning of next Session.
- Design & Implementation stage
- Meet with school to discuss design plan.
- Good meeting with the designer, positive and happy with the school requests
- TRO plans to be shared closure to traffic during school hours- parking suspended.
- Further TRO can be submitted with the amendments when the other one is in place.
- Additional TRO would be a parallel process.
- An ETRO (Experimental TRO) which requires no legislation can also be applied for and these last for 18 months.
- Close area from school to nature strip during school hours
- Pedestrians/Bike Lane to be channeled along the nature strip side of the pavement.
- Fire/Ambulance happy with TRO plans
- ETRO and TRO are separate processes.
- LeeAnne are there any anticipated costs related to the road closure and design?
- No anticipated cost at this stage but the school may want to purchase extra play/safety equipment later which may
  incur costs.
- Could free parking at drop-off and pick-up times be considered to make the process easier and encourage parents to park a little further away from the school? Ie Lauder Road etc
- Signage & barriers to show times of the road closure.
